Senate Bill 8 was passed in 2019 and requires a statewide flood plan based on regional flood plans. The Key Tasks of the Sabine Regional Flood Planning Group (RFPG), representing 21 counties that comprise the Sabine Basin, are to: gather and analyze data; identify existing and future flood risks; evaluate floodplain management practices; recommend evaluations, strategies, and projects to reduce flood risks; and to develop a regional flood plan.

The Sabine RFPG is soliciting public input regarding suggestions and recommendations as to issues, provisions, projects, and strategies that should be considered during the flood planning cycle and/or input on the development of the regional flood plan (as required per Texas Water Code §16.062(d) and 31 Texas Administrative Code §361.12(a)(4)).

The public is invited to attend the open house style meeting at a convenient time between 5:30 PM – 7:00 PM wherein representatives will be on hand to discuss existing conditions in the Sabine Basin and receive input from the public. The public meeting will display the existing conditions flood risk for the basin and will allow the public to provide comment on flood prone areas to be included as part of the Sabine Regional Flood Plan.
