- Technical consultant conference today to discuss TDIS.

Agenda Item 10: Region 5. Neches RFPG Report.

- Douglas Manning noted they had a public outreach meeting last week. Next meeting is January 27th at LNVA office.
- Second outreach meeting was better than the first.

Agenda Item 11: Update from Freese and Nichols

- Mat Leclair presented an update to the RFPG members.
 - The upcoming schedule was discussed, notably the upcoming deadline for the extended items within Task 2 which are due to TWDB in early March 2022. The revised tech memo will need to be voted on and approved at the February RFPG meeting.
 - The current approach was outlined, and graphics were shown depicting the different floodplain delineations within Orange County.
 - Concerns about the latest Fathom data were brought up, notably that the extents of the data were significantly larger than the current FEMA mapping in the region.
 - The hierarchy of usable data was highlighted noting that FEMA data would be the highest priority followed by BLE, FEMA Zone A, and finally Fathom.
 - Concerns from the RFPG members were expressed nothing that FEMA data is sometimes a redelineation of older modeling data which may have been done a long time ago.
 - The RFPG requested FNI to provide a memo to the group outlining the sources of the floodplain data, strategies, as well as dates of detailed modeling that FNI is recommending to the group.
 - FNI highlighted that a large portion of the Sabine River watershed does not have adequate detailed floodplain mapping and FNI would consider these as mapping gaps as part of the Regional Flood Plan document and exhibits.
 - FNI outlined the schedule for the coming months leading up to the first draft submittal
 of the Regional Flood Plan in August 2022 and noted that draft chapters would be
 provided to the group in phases for review and discussion rather than a single draft
 document when all of the chapters are compiled.





Existing Flood Hazard Area




Future Flood Hazard Area



Task 3A – Floodplain Management Practices

- Goal: Evaluate/recommend floodplain management practices
 - 1. Identify and reduce the risk and impact to life and property that already exists
 - 2. Avoid increasing or creating new flood risk by addressing future development within the areas known to have existing or future flood risk.
- Floodplain management, land use, infrastructure design, and other practices play a key role in accomplishing both of these intents, specifically in preventing the creation of additional flood risk in the future.
- Practices will be Recommended <u>not</u> Adopted per Sabine RFPG
